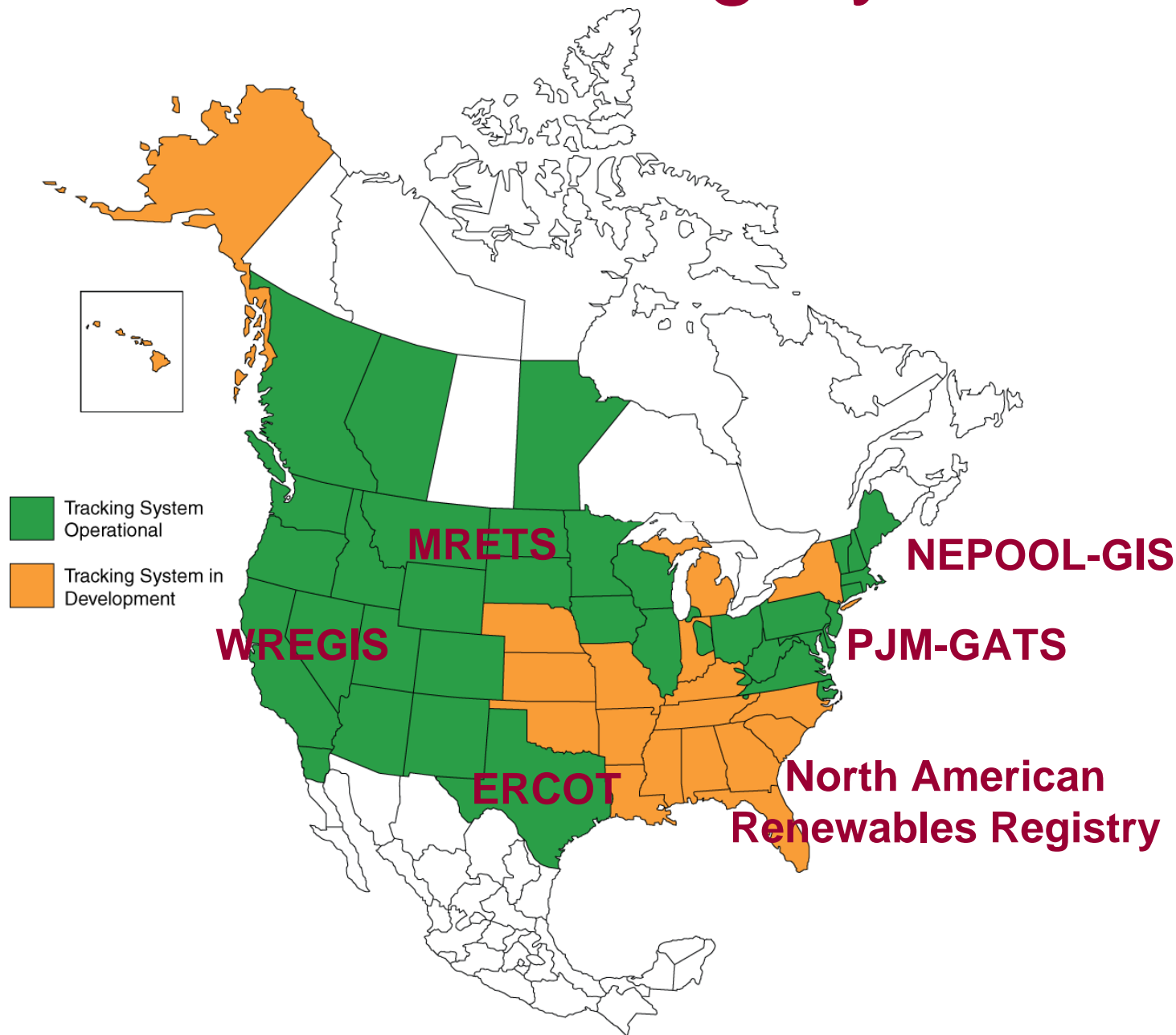
ETNNA Mission & Goals

- And foster the development of new systems

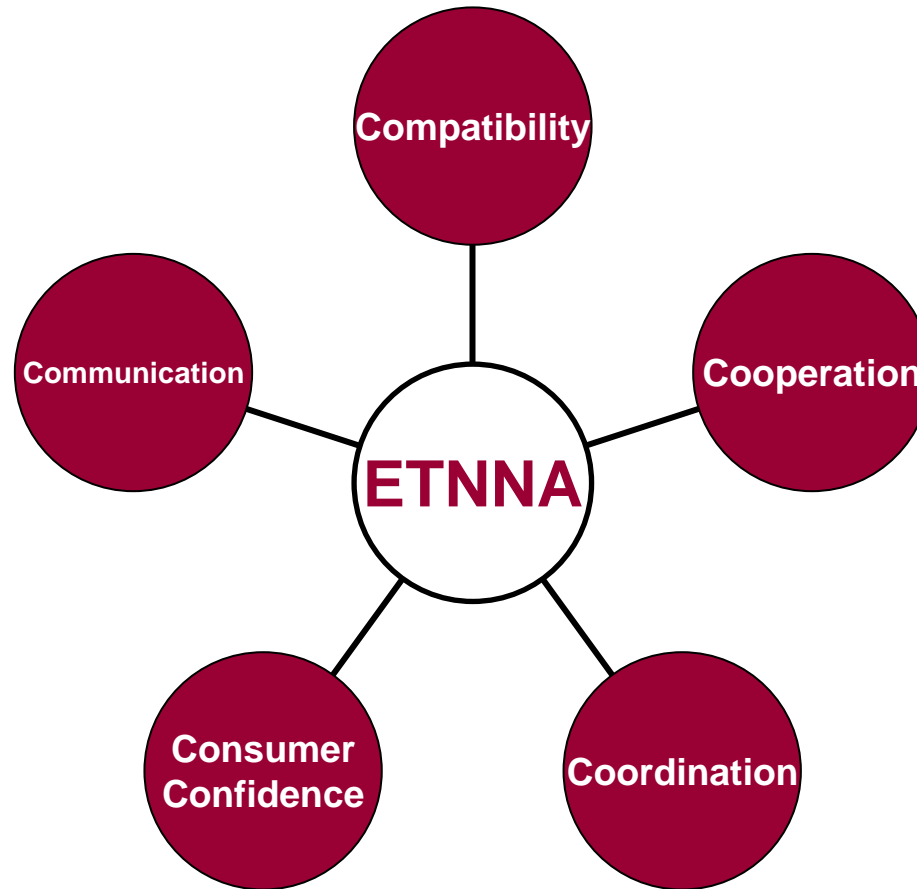
Brief History of ETNNA

- Closely modeled after the European “**Association of Issuing Bodies (AIB)**”

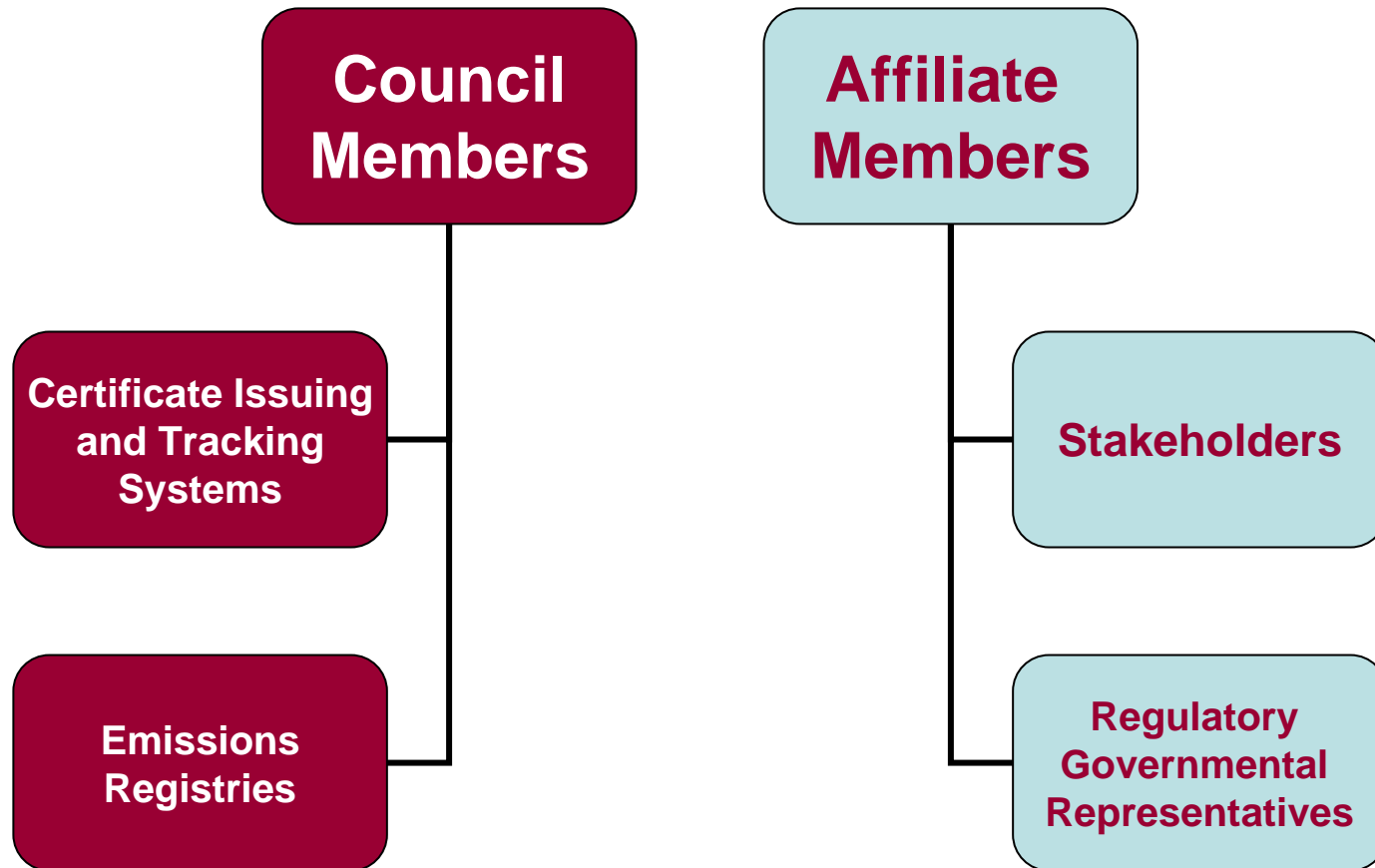
Certificate Tracking Systems



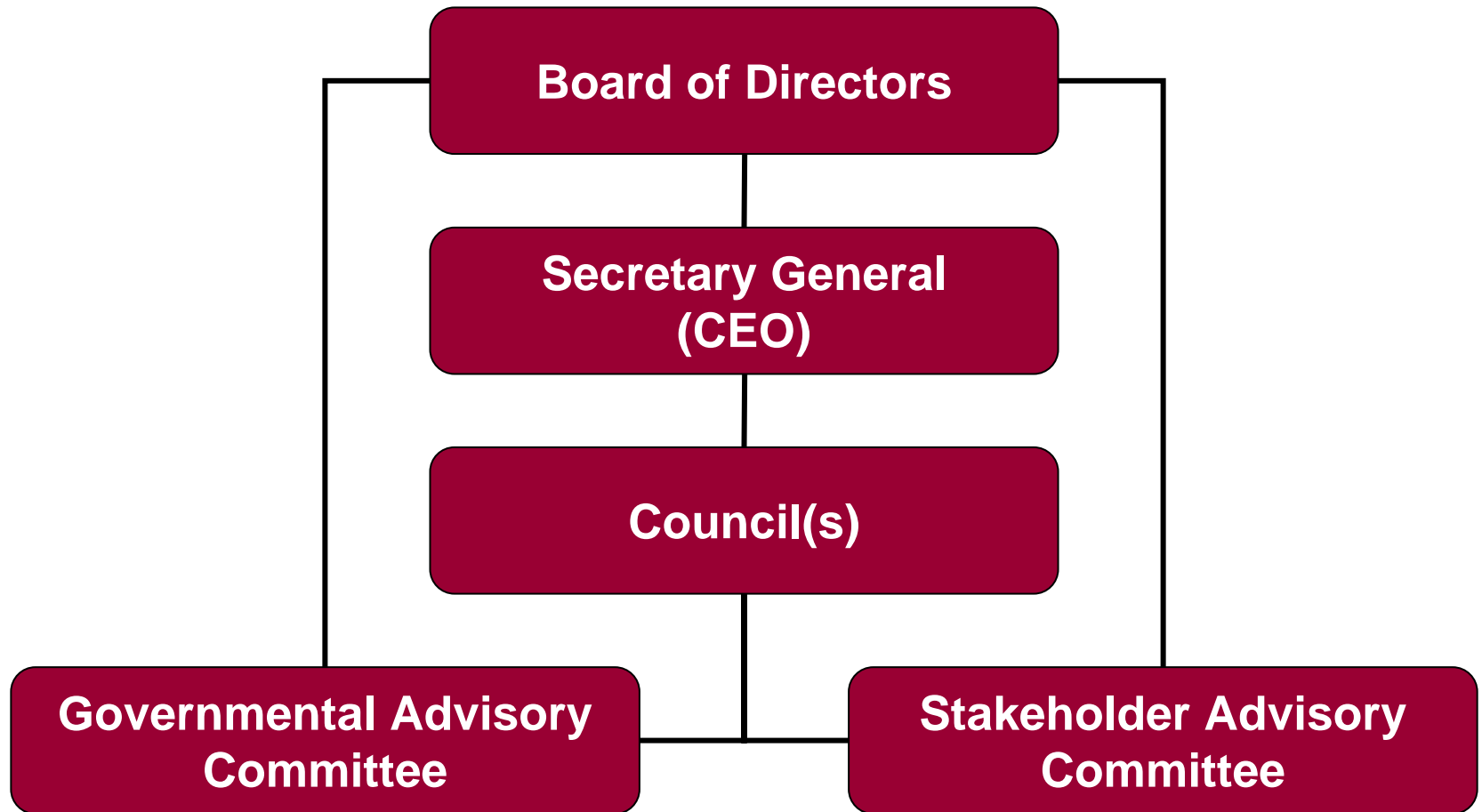
ETNNA Core Values
